

## Illustrated Glossary of ral's Technical Terms

<b>3pb</b>	three-price break trend
<b>3per</b>	three-period rolling range trend
<b>3-set</b>	A method for developing opening range triggers
<b>AC</b>	Additive candle
<b>BBR</b>	Bull/Bear Reserve
<b>BC</b>	bozu controller (the body midpoint of the ruling bozu above or below the market)
<b>BMP</b>	Body mid-point (the midpoint between the open and close of a period)
<b>BP</b>	Breakprice...the price (typically a close) that breaks (reverses) the prevailing trend
<b>BW</b>	body weight
<b>CF</b>	carry forward 3pb
<b>CG</b>	Center of gravity: based on equal weighting of candle points (open, high, low, close)
<b>CON</b>	continuous 3pb method
<b>CP</b>	Candle pattern
<b>CPZ</b>	Critical price zone ... derived from the scissors method
<b>CTR</b>	current trading range as defined by most recently formed market structures
<b>DSS</b>	downside structure (dss is a downside structure interior to a prevailing USS)
<b>DTR</b>	daily trading range as defined by complete market structures
<b>EBB</b>	Extreme Bollinger Band (13 periods ema and 2.618 standard deviation envelopes)
<b>EOB</b>	end of box
<b>EOBV</b>	end of box volatility
<b>EOR</b>	refers to eighth of range used in setting targets, stops and gaintaking points
<b>FOPS</b>	Fall off pattern signa;...a berish candle pattern
<b>FS</b>	fresh start 3pb
<b>GA</b>	Gann Angle
<b>GMP</b>	Globex mid-point
<b>LTS</b>	Long term stop
<b>LWWB</b>	Larry Williams' Weekly Buy signal
<b>LWWS</b>	Larry Williams' Weekly Sell signal
<b>msh</b>	market structure high
<b>msl</b>	market structure low
<b>MTR</b>	major trading range in the past 89 sessions
<b>NC</b>	Non-confirmation
<b>NH</b>	new high
<b>NL</b>	new low
<b>NS</b>	Natural Square
<b>NS8</b>	Natural Square price line at every 8th of current Natural Square range
<b>Nullification</b>	Price has violated a structural price point; a major reversal signature
<b>OF</b>	open filter 3pb
<b>ORM</b>	opening range method ("to orm" means to use the ranges of reference as triggers)

<b>PT</b>	Pricetime
<b>PTB</b>	pricetime box
<b>PTBox</b>	Refers to the 34-period during which waves (bullish or bearish) form and grow
<b>R:R</b>	Reward:Risk estimate for any trade. Desireable trades are $R:R > 2.00$
<b>RMP</b>	Range mid-point (the mid-point between high and low of aperiod)
<b>Scissors</b>	A method for projecting future prices based on two defined periods
<b>Slingshot</b>	A rapid reversal of trend following price hitting the upper or lower EBB
<b>SS</b>	“slingshot” move from EBB
<b>T</b>	target
<b>TOPS</b>	Take off pattern signal...a bullish candle pattern
<b>TR</b>	trigger
<b>TRW</b>	trend weight
<b>TSW</b>	Total Scissors Weight derived from the scissors method
<b>USS</b>	upside structure (uss is an upside structure interior to a prevailing DSS)
<b>V/C</b>	void of course moon
<b>V/C</b>	Void of course:refers to the moon's period without aspect prior to entering next sign
<b>VOS</b>	Void of Structure (post 34-period end of box before fully formed structure occurs)
<b>VR</b>	volatility reversal
<b>X</b>	An important "center of gravity" type projection derived from the scissors
